Proposed BSkyB - News Corp merger

The DCMS SoS is currently considering the public interest in a proposed merger of BSkyB with News Corporation, in line with obligations under the Enterprise Act. The SoS has stated that he is minded to accept Ofcom's conclusions that he should refer the merger to the Competition Commission. The SoS has, however, indicated that he will consider any "undertakings in lieu" offered by the merging in parties to address the potential impact on media plurality.

We do not recommend raising this issue, since the decision is a quasi-judicial process, which is not subject to collective decision making procedures.
