Examples of the impact of fraud on productions

- Less funding available to deliver the editorial standards/vision
- If production assets misappropriated they may not be replaceable
- Increases restrictions on editorial ambitions (e.g. ban on competitions and votes in 2007)
- Potential increase in bureaucracy as a result of new controls to mitigate risk may hamper ability to deliver production to design
