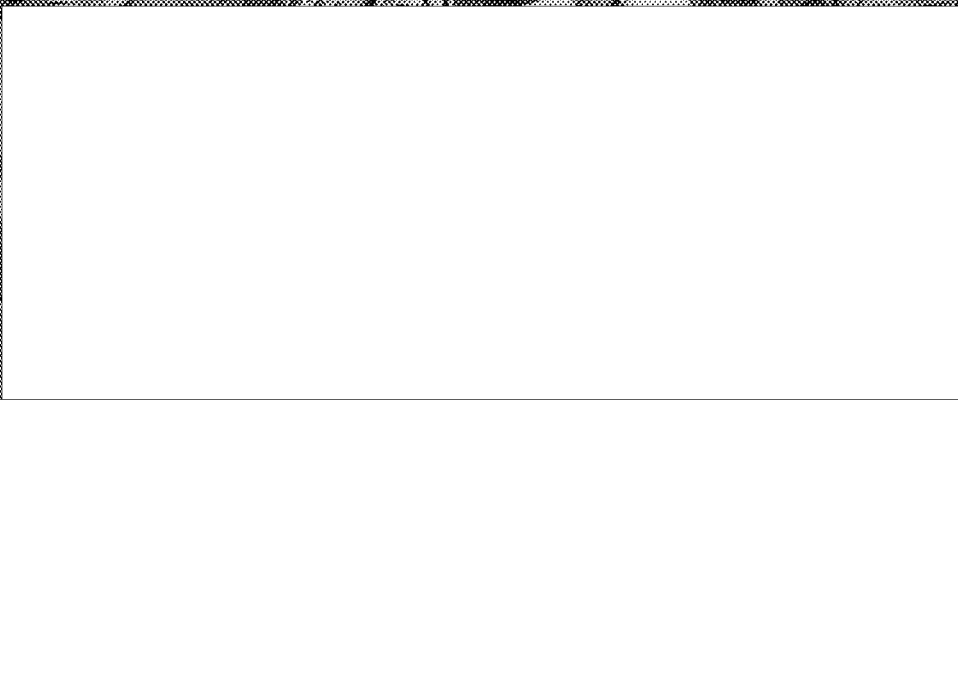
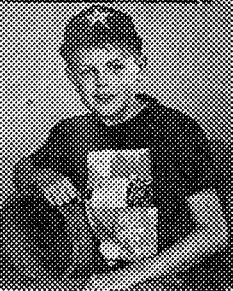
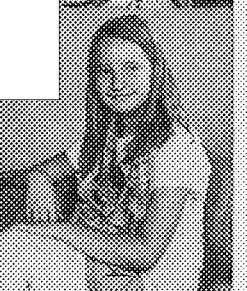
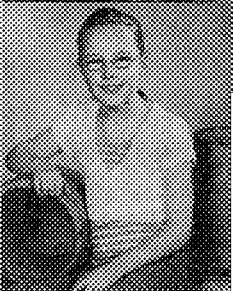
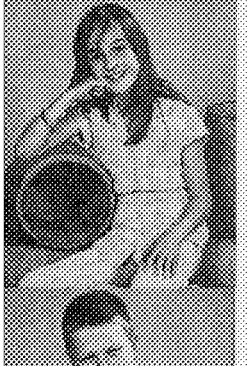
593 1st Sebastian Bowles smiles in the film — days before he becomes the only British victim of the Swiss coach horror that killed 22 kids.

# SKI CRASH BRIT BOY'S HEARTBREAK BLOG

**A BRITISH boy among the 22 coach kids killed on a ski trip told his family he was having the time of his life.**

Tragic 11-year-old Sebastian Bowles wrote an excited message on a school "blog" as the end of the holiday loomed.

He addressed it to "Dear Mamma, Papa, Nelsus and Popsy" and told them: "I can already see quite well".

The father said the boy "thought to have had hot dogs" and "bought 23 buses before he died". It's really great here.

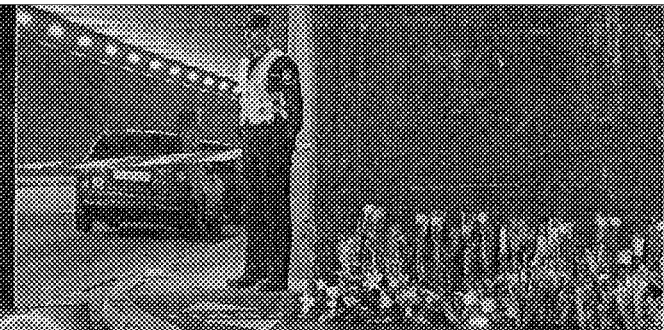
The regiment was sent to the front line on Monday as the first of the children killed in the "Kosovian" were taken to the hospital.

Victims were pupils from two schools in Belgium - one of which Sebastian went to.

All four teachers on the coach "were" from London and the Alps were also killed - along with the driver and his deputy.

Last night Sebastian's dad Edward, who moved his family from London two years ago to be near his singing "wife's" family, was gut-wrenching.

The 40 Whitehall rounds - now a high-flier at Standard Chartered Bank -

was still waiting for final confirmation of his son's death. Many of them, killed as the coach crashed into a tunnel wall, were having to be identified by DNA.

Sebastian's distraught mum Ann, 48, has her hair band in Switzerland as the grim task proceeded.

She had earlier sobbed uncontrollably with other parents at the gates of St Lambert School in Haverhill, England, near the boy's home in London.

The family, previously lived in Goshen Fed, North London. Dad Edward is thought to regularly com-

mute to their new home while remaining based in London. He is a former head of human rights at the Ministry of Justice - and worked as chief of staff to two government ministers.

A shocked parent at Sebastian's old school - Our Lady of Maxwell RC Primary in Maxwell Hill - said: "He was a lovely boy, friendly and full of fun. We all remember his smile."

"His friends here don't believe what has happened," Sebastian's mum had been a school governor.

The parent said: "The whole family were well liked and respected."

"They moved to Belgium for quality of life and to be near Ann's parents, which makes the tragedy even more heart-rending." A fam-

ily friend said: "It is heart-breaking news. ... Three surviving children were still in a coma last night. At least 21 others were also hurt - some suffering appalling injuries."

Survivors suggested teacher had struggled to load a DVD for people to watch - and the driver may have been distracted as he tried to help. Investigators say CCTV from the tunnel and the town of Sorens did not back the theory. But they ruled out fears the driver was speeding.

It is a national mourning today as people gathered in Brussels to pay tribute to the victims.
