Thank you for your letter of 18<sup>th</sup> October.

We have in the past issued guidance to the press on the separate, but linked, issue of not harassing judges to comment on their sentences – which, of course, they are not permitted to do. The issue you raise is also important. There was a recent discussion about it at a meeting of the Editors' Code of Practice Committee, which writes and reviews the rules that the Commission enforces. The view at the moment is that the Code as currently drafted should cover the type of situation that the Select Committee is concerned about. What we need now is for the PCC to receive a solid complaint under Clause 1 (Accuracy), so that we can articulate publicly where the boundaries lie in reporting this subject. Meantime, I can assure you that we will keep the matter under close review.
