Congratulations on your new appointment.

We have been grateful for the fruitful dialogue that we have had with the Conservative Party on matters to do with freedom of expression and press regulation. This is something that I hope will continue.

There are currently of course a number of challenges for media regulators posed by new technologies and convergence. We think that the PCC's structure and approach – flexibility, independence, the co-operation of the regulated industry, and the application of principles rather than prescriptive rules - are well suited to the new landscape.

We have also entrenched several reforms to the PCC over the last few years in order to guarantee transparency and accountability, which I hope has led to greater trust in the Commission's work.

I would welcome the opportunity to brief you on these issues and also to hear your own views. I know you will be very busy but I wonder whether you – and any of your advisers or shadow ministerial colleagues, if appropriate – might be free some time in the autumn for a private dinner with me and the Commission's Director, Tim Toulmin.
